Title I Parent and Family Engagement Policy 2023-2024 School Year

Policy Involvement: Our parents were involved in the approval of this plan with our School Improvement Team (SIT). Our SIT met on September 28, 2023 to review and finalize our school's Title I Parent and Family Engagement Policy for the 2023-2024 School Year. Our SIT has a parent on the team. Glade Creek School faculty and staff believe that parent involvement in education is a key component of student success. Student achievement and character are influenced positively when parents are involved in the school. Glade Creek offers several programs and activities to create relationships with parents.

Shared Responsibility for High Student Academic Achievement: Our parents and staff planning has the goal of having strong relationships. School, parent, and student responsibilities are written to improve our academic achievement of North Carolina teaching and learning standards. Activities this year include:

- An Open House grade-level format parent meetings will be scheduled on August 17 to share the purpose of our Title I school wide program.
- Our Parent Compact will be sent home the first month of school. The Parent Compact will show the responsibilities of school personnel, parents, and students that promote student success at school.
- Parent workshops and conferences will be held throughout the year to promote better student success in reading, math, science, and behavior.
- Scheduled parent conferences will be held at the end of each quarter; and at the request of parents or teachers.

Building Capacity for Involvement: Our Open House, parent conferences, and literacy activities, are intentional about providing ways that parents can better support their student achievement at home. Other community learning opportunities will be shared in the community for our families to attend remotely if needed. Specific activities include:

- School administration and teachers will provide information to parents about special activities, events, and programs through ConnectEd and Remind accounts.
- Zoom meetings; phone calls, notes, and newsletters.
- Information will be provided by Allegheny County Schools and the State of North Carolina for parents to be used at home for information and student learning resources.
- Weekly “student work folders” will be provided and taken home by students each week. Each folder will contain student work and notes to parents.
- Limited English proficiency homes will have an interpreter provided upon request by the parent or teacher.
- Reading logs and student achievement in our reading program will be shared with parents by our instructional staff.

Accessibility: Parents are always welcome at our school. The school returns each email and phone call within twenty-four hours. Zoom meetings, Connect Ed phone calls, school website, Facebook account, twitter account and weekly folders are used to invite, and encourage parent involvement in our school meetings and academic learning nights.

Funding: Title one parent engagement funds are used to purchase materials and text that allow our staff to showcase best practices in literacy, mathematics, and science.
