

AIG Screening & Identification Flowchart

Screening Pool (Fall-Spring)

Mass Screening

Cogat administered in the fall to 3rd grade students

Nominations

Students who are not in the screening year can be nominated by the AIG Coordinator, teachers, and/or administrators.



Evaluations & Data Collection

After parental permission is obtained the CogAT is administered which measures a student's aptitude and reasoning skills.

In addition to the CogAT, the AIG Coordinator collects other sources of data including achievement and ability scores, teacher checklists, parent surveys, classroom grades, and work samples.



Student Success Team Review SST Meets to Review Data for Eligibility Determination and Placement

Student Success Team (SST) reviews all data. If data indicates giftedness a recommendation for services is made. If data doesn't indicate giftedness students continue regular education services. Some students may be placed on a "Watch List."

Parents meet with the AIG Coordinator to sign a Differentiated Education Plan (DEP) for placement in the program. DEPs will be reviewed on an annual basis.



Services

Service Delivery Plan is Matched to the Student's Identification Area

AIG Coordinator works with classroom teachers to determine student services match based on student data and Array of Services.

AIG Coordinator, classroom teachers, and other support staff deliver differentiated services.
