HOW TO I EARN CDM?

The CDM process requires a student application/family agreement and multiphase assessments. The phases are as follows:

Phase 1: Assessment

 Students take an examination to establish their mastery of the foundational skills and content that the course requires.

Phase 2: Artifact Development

- Students demonstrate the ability to apply their deep understanding of the content standards.
- Student receive clear expectations and guidance regarding artifact development.
